

How Do I Request a Letter of Invitation?

To assist international attendees in obtaining a visa, HostingCon will issue you a letter of invitation that you may present at your interview. To obtain a letter of invitation, you must first register for the conference and pay registration fees in full. No letters will be issued without a paid conference registration.

Note: It has been suggested to us that you should have a hotel booked and paid for as well.

Visa Waiver Program

International attendees who are nationals of countries listed in the Visa Waiver Program (VWP) may be able to travel to the United States for 90 days or less without obtaining a visa.

Please note: All VWP travelers from the 27 eligible countries, regardless of age or type of passport used, must present individual machine-readable passports to enter the United States.

What is the Process to Apply for a Visa?
